GAIQVET

GAIQVET project, funded by the European program LLP - Comenius Regio, will provide educational institutions with common tools for improving inspection and quality in Vocational Centres after a detailed research of the educational systems in both participant countries.

AIM OF THE PROJECT

The aim of the project is the development of guidance and control qualification in order to improve the quality of vocational education.

An efficient guidance and auditing for vocational education is urged in order to:

- Have information about the most current research and practice.
- Solve the communication problems between auditors and education staff of vocational institutions.
- Create an area of confidence between the staff and inspectors to enhance the quality of the vocational education.

TARGET GROUPS

Two main target groups will be involved:

- Inspectors, quality managers and staff in charge of guidance and supervision at vocational education institutions.
- Managers, teachers and staff working in vocational training schools.

HOW

In order to reach the goals of the project, vocational education institutions in the participant countries will carry out the following tasks:

- Exploring the guidance and control applications by doing on-site observation and analysis.
- Sharing information and experiences on auditing practices in vocational education in the field of early school education.

EXPECTED RESULTS

- A comparative report will be the starting point of the expecting outcomes.
- An analysis of the actual situation will try to find out the obstacles between inspectors and vocational education staff.
- A guidance book will be edited after the initial research in order to include the strategies for improving quality in auditing and inspection tasks.
- Pilot trainings will be applied both to the inspectors and the vocational education staff to check the efficiency. Evaluation of the whole work will be valorised in two conferences organised by the participant countries.
